### **School Annual Report 2018-19**

This is Icchashri Desai taking you through the wonderful journey of Sangameshwar Public School.

Our vision is to build a strong community of highly sensitive 21st century learners rooted in Indian values and prepare them to be responsible and productive global citizens. Shri Sangameshwar Education society was formed by Late Karmayogi Appasaheb Kadadi and his late brother Shri.Nagappanna Kadadi with the same vision many years ago for they wanted to make quality education accessible to the people of Solapur. Late Shri.Megharaj Kadadi continued the same legacy and passed it onto respected Hemalata Kadadi and Shri. Dharmaraj. Kadadi who with their devotion and commitment and perseverance have been able to take the institution to newer heights. Sangameshwar Public School is the brain child of Shri. Dharmaraj Kadadi sir and it is hoped that there will be tremendous response for his conceptual school for small kids.

The school started functioning in the academic year 2015-16 with 115 students on roll. The no. shot up to 335 in the next year with the introduction of grades 1 to 8. This year the no. has risen to 606. The school follows CBSE curriculum .We moved to the newly constructed building that has all amenities like a well equipped library, Maths lab, science lab, computer lab etc. On June 18<sup>th</sup> 2018, we shifted to new building for the beginning of new session.

The school was established with a vision that learning would be real fun and we would be taught through activities combined with real life experiences. It provides us a safe , supportive and nurturing environment and cultivate the potential of every student through active engagement in the learning process. Most of the subjects are taught through activities and difficult concepts are made simple through experiential learning. I shall give you the brief report of activities done and programmes conducted that are in sync with the mission statement.

#### **Achievements**

The year 2018 has been very lucky for Sangameshwarians as some students registered remarkable achievements. Iccha Desai that is me won Best Performer award in National Space Science Essay writing Competition conducted through The Hindu. Nasa. My essay ' A day spent in space' won me a scholarship of Rs 30000 and an opportunity to visit NASA.

Out of the 305 participants, There were all together 305 participants there were 13 Gold medal winners 7 Silver and Bronze medal winners all together. The school has become a hub of many co-scholastic activities. They are no more considered extra-curricular activities as they are linked to true learning experiences. We conducted a host of competitions like wall magazine, declamation competition, book review competition, story telling competitions and handwriting competition for grade 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>.
