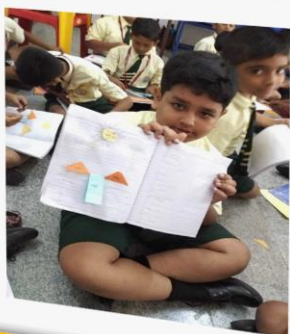
Lokmanya Tilak Birth Anniversary 23rd July
